BASKETRY WORKSHOPS

All basketry workshops must have a min. of 6 pre-registered students by **May 16, 2020**. Cancelled classes will be posted on our website after that date: www.nwbasketweavers.org. The max. number of students in a class is 10 – 12. You will receive a confirmation of your class by May 20, 2020.

Cancellation Policy: Your materials fee will be refunded if you cancel prior to the deadline of May 16, 2020, less a \$5.00 administration fee. After the deadline, there will be a refund only if your place can be filled from the waiting list, or you find a replacement student for the class.

CLASS # 1: CEDAR NECKLACE POUCH

Teacher: JO ANN HART

This little necklace pouch makes a great gift and yours can be designed using your choice of waxed linen thread, western red cedar bark, both natural and dyed, yellow cedar bark, and leather cordage and beads. Learn twining techniques and the Lash/Fold/Flip rim Size 1 ½" x 2"

Weaving is done over a wooden mold that is yours to keep. Written instructions included for future use.

Materials Fee: \$35.00 Class Fee: \$10.00

Class length: 6 hours

Maximum number of students: 12

Level of Experience: all levels but beginners may not finish in class.



CLASS #2: WILDERNESS WALKING STICK

Teacher: GEORGE HART

Hike the Olympics with this dandy Devils Club walking stick. The handle weaving can be designed by you using various threads, yarns, western red cedar bark, beads, and misc. materials. Twining techniques used. Rim is shredded. Bring personal beads and embellishments if you choose. Wood burner available for adding name or designs time permitting.

Material fee: \$50.00 Class Fee: \$10.00

Class length: 6 hours

Maximum# of students: 12

Level of Experience: all levels – twining experience helpful.



CLASS # 3 – CHASING BEARGRASS

Teacher: POLLY SUTTON

Chase twine NW sweet grass over prepared cedar bark while simultaneously weaving bear grass. The finish is a saw tooth or twined down border.

Materials Fee: \$80.00 Class Fee \$10.00

Class length: 6 hours

Maximum# of students: 10

Level of Experience: Intermediate

Tools to bring: all the basic



CLASS # 4 - 'ARAN' FLOWER BASKET

Teacher: KATHERINE LEWIS

This sweet little basket comes from the Aran Islands in Ireland. With no base at all, we start by tying together a group of stakes (willow) and then flare out the sides as we go up using a 'slewing' weave. The basket is completed with a 'trac' border and small handle to hang the basket on your wall or door.

Materials fee: \$30.00 Class fee: \$5.00

Class length: 3 hours (9 – noon)

Maximum # of students - 10

Tools to bring: Awl, clippers. Some tools will be available to borrow.

Level of Experience: all levels – hand strength required



CLASS # 5 - WILLOW TENSION TRAY

Teacher: KATHERINE LEWIS

Working on a prepared hoop, students will use a selection of willow sticks to make a lovely tray, perfect for holding fruit. Simple tied handles are the finishing touch. Some hand strength is needed as always for willow.

Materials fee: \$35.00 Class fee: \$5.00

Class length: 3 hours (1:00 – 4:00)

Maximum # of students - 10

Tools to bring: Awl, clippers. Some tools will be available to borrow.

Level of Experience: all levels – hand strength required



CLASS # 6 – OLDE TIMEY DOLLS

Teacher: KAY HARRADINE

What child across the ages hasn't adored a favorite handmade dolly? Create your own examples with simple plant and animal fibers. Make a pair of Native cattail dolls, a pioneer age cornhusk doll, a simple wire and stuffing body for an apple head you'll carve. Take it home and watch it cure into wrinkles as it dries.

Materials fee: \$25.00 Class fee: \$10.00

Class length: 6 hours

Maximum # of students 10

Skill level- all. Including teens and children under 13 accompanied by an adult.

Students to bring - sharp paring knife, band aid, small pliers, scissors, needle and thread, sewing scraps, trimmings, etc.
