Teaching fees are subsidized by Northwest Basket Weavers Guild.

Material fees are paid to the instructors and due with your registration.

Basketry Workshops: 9:30 – 3:30

Basket making Demonstrations: 10:00 – 3:00

Register in advance to reserve your space, or drop in for a possible open seat – first come/first serve – equal opportunity for members and non-members. Teaching fees are subsidized by Northwest Basket Weavers Guild.

You pay only a nominal class fee to help support the event and the materials fee.

BASKETRY WORKSHOPS

All basketry workshops must have a min. of 6 pre-registered students by May 1, 2019. Cancelled classes will be posted on our website after that date: www.nwbasketweavers.org. The max. number of students in a class is 10 – 12. You will receive a confirmation of your class by May 6, 2019. *Cancellation Policy: Your materials fee will be refunded if you cancel prior to the deadline of May 1, 2019, less a \$5.00 administration fee. After the deadline, there will be a refund only if your place can be filled from the waiting list, or you find a replacement student for the class.*

CLASS #1 - MAMFOK: TO WEAVE Teacher: ROQUIN-JON Q. SIONCO
Materials fee \$30.00. Class fee: \$10.00. 4 hours (choose morning or afternoon) Skill Level: beginner & up. The basket will be woven with fresh palm leaves. (Cocos nucifera) using techniques found throughout the Pacific. Approximate finished size: x 12” x 5”. All necessary tools supplied by teacher. Maximum # of students 12



CLASS #2 - CEDAR BARK PRIMITIVE DOLL Teacher: Jo Hart
Materials fee: \$20.00. Class fee: \$10.00. 5 hours. Skill Level: beginner & up. Use your creativity to make and decorate a primitive cedar doll with cedar bark, Swiss straw or raffia, beads, etc. Choice of colors for clothing, hair and accessories yours to make for your little woven person. What's its name going to be? Approximate finished size 6” (sizes will vary) Tools to bring: scissors, awl for packing. Maximum # of students 12



CLASS #3 - PORCUPINE QUILLS ON BIRCH BARK LAPEL PIN
Teacher: Kathey Ervin. Materials fee: \$50.00. Class fee: \$10.00. 5 hours. All levels (must have stitching ability) That's right – stitching with porcupine quills! A double layer of birch bark is scored with your choice of pattern – floral or geometric, then quills – natural white and dyed in an array of colors will be stitched onto the bark. The piece ends with a fragrant border of sweet grass. Approximate finished size: Diameter 2.5”. Tools: small hemostat, small sharp scissor, small sharp awl – Instructor will have tools to borrow. Maximum # of students 6



CLASS #4 – SPRING CACHEPOT Teacher: Diane Banks
 Materials Fee: \$15.00. Class fee: \$10.00. 2 hours. Parent-accompanied children’s class. Choose morning or afternoon class. This is a small cachepot meant to hold a 4 inch houseplant. The student will learn the chase-weave to form the radial base, twining the sides of the basket with seagrass (easy to use for beginners), add natural or colored reed in a start-stop plain weave to add their own creativity, add a few more rows of seagrass and finish with a folded no-lash rim. Approx. finished size:



CLASS #5 – MINIATURE SWEET GRASS AND CEDAR BARK BASKET
 Teacher: Polly Sutton. Materials Fee \$50.00. Class fee: \$10.00. 5 hours. Intermediate level. Using western red cedar bark as the structure, this little basket will be twined with NW sweet grass with an accent of triple twining or skip stitch. Approximate finished size: 1 1/4” x 1 1/4” x 2” Maximum # of students 10



CLASS #6 – CUP BASKET Teacher: Mary Auld. Materials fee: \$3.00
 Class fee: \$10.00. This little basket is for parent-accompanied children 5 years and older. Reeds are poked into a Styrofoam cup and then woven around the cup with yarn and other materials. When weaving is finished the cup is broken off and you have a small, shallow basket. A handle may also be added. Approximate finished size 8” x 5”. Bring scissors & awl. Maximum # of students 12



CLASS #7 – SWIRLING TWINED MEDALLION Teacher: Kay Harradine
 Materials fee: \$35.00 Class Fee: \$10.00 Choose from three patterns or design your own. Weave a small flat circular disk from waxed linen using 2 and 3 strand twining to make bright moving patterns. Skills taught include maintaining consistent tension and adding spokes. We’ll throw in a little math and a little color theory for creating designs. Approximate finished size 1.5” – 2” diameter. All skill levels. Some twining experience recommended. 5 hours. Tools to bring – Small sharp scissors, tapestry needle. Maximum # of students 10
